

Camden Township Regular Meeting

July 14, 2022

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, July 14, 2022, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Kayla Coil, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Goede, seconded by Devine to approve the regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll, and claims for payment of \$56,104.39. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer’s report, and stating the Clerk and Treasurer’s books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk’s Report: Shared MAT Meeting August 10th in St. Peter, MN; Carver County building permits; Met Council’s population for Camden Township had 364 housing units, 347 households, and 942 people as of April 1, 2021; Notice of Pay Equity Compliance for 2022 reporting.

Supervisors Report: Motion was made by Zellmann that Camden Township no longer provide dust control on private property. Goede said he will reach out to those properties and provide them with some company names that could be contacted for dust control. Devine shared that the Carver County Township meeting is going to be held on July 26th, 2022, at 7pm at the Carver County Fairgrounds.

Discussion Included:

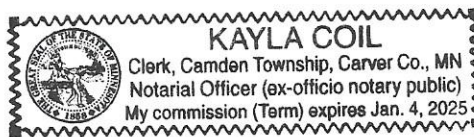

2. Spoke about appointing Election judges for Primary Election. Provided a list of Election judges that have been reached out to. Zellmann made a motion to approve the election judges, Goede seconded the motion, motion carried.
3. Devine stated the Board of Adjustments has 7 people on there but would like to see more townships involved.

Road & Equipment Report: Mowing is almost done. Chloride on roads is complete.
