

**Camden Township Regular Meeting**

**September 8th, 2022**

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, September 8th, 2022, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Kayla Coil, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, & Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll, and claims for payment of \$9,137.86. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer’s report, and stating the Clerk and Treasurer’s books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

**Clerk’s Report:** Shared everyone is registered for the MAT Annual Meeting in October, Carver County building permits.

**Supervisors Report:** None.


**Discussion Included:**

1. Discussed the Annexation of Schroder Meats from Camden Township into the City of New Germany. Motion was made by Goede seconded by Zellmann to waive the notice for Petition for Annexation and for Schroder Meats to pay 10 years of taxes. 2022 Camden tax is \$900.57x10 years = \$9,005.70. Clerk is continuing to work with City of New Germany, awaiting proper documentation.
2. Due to conflict with the MAT Annual Conference, a motion was made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to move the monthly township meeting in October from October 13<sup>th</sup> to October 12<sup>th</sup>. Clerk posted Notice of change.
3. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to submit the 2023 Levy Certification to Carver County.
4. Commissioner John Fahey attended with County updates. 212 Road Construction updates, County Road 32 bridge scheduled to open November 2022, Connect up Carver, and the 2023 Preliminary Levy and Budget. Fahey also stated that the 2022 Carver County Fair was a great success this year.
