**February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 7:30pm. Members present were Clerk Kayla Coil, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, & Bill Devine. The guests present were Kyle Heuer, Al Sherwood, Jennifer Ray, Al Chapman, Chad Braun, Nick Johnson & John Fahey. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve the regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve the Organizational & Budget Minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll, and claims for payment of \$6,027.50. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer’s report, stating the Clerk and Treasurer’s books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

**Clerk’s Report:** Called Carver County about an updated address list for Annual Mtg postcards, \$40 to run the report fee to obtain the address list from the county.

**Supervisors Report:** Township day at the State Capitol is April 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> in St. Paul.

**Discussion Included:**

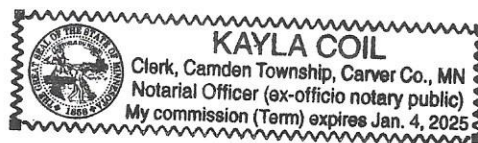
1. Kyle Heuer – Follow up from previous meeting. Camden Township does not allow building eligibilities to be moved to non-adjacent parcels. Camden Township cannot do anything to amend the Comp Plan at this time.
2. Chad Braun – Cty Rd 135 (existing home) – looking for a variance for an approved garage. Zellmann approved, Goede seconded with the Counties recommendations.
3. Al Sherwood / Jennifer Ray / Al Chapman – Election Integrity – Goal of vetted party balance, looking to get a resolution from the county / county commissioner to support vetted major party balance.
4. Nick Johnson, City of Mayer, Administrator – to speak on 2025 Fire Contracts for Mayer.
5. John Fahey – Discussed Carver County Sign ordinance, Camden Township’s opinion is to leave it alone. Carver County is the fastest growing county in the state with 17.2% growth, we are also the healthiest county in the state for 11 years, and the 5<sup>th</sup> healthiest in the United States. Fahey shared that estimated market value is up, and the hwy 212 project work has started with moving trees.
6. Motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Employee Sick & Safe Time Policy (ESST). Motion carried.
7. Website – Up to date, will send Minutes & Treasurer Reports as necessary.
8. Zellmann reported that Plato Fire Mtg staying the same as 2023.
9. Goede reported that NYA Fire – no new equipment.

**Road & Equipment Report:** Roads are in good condition, 3 signs were straightened out, Dead end sign will be going up (Not sure on location).
