

## Camden Township Regular Meeting

March 10, 2022

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, March 10, 2022, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, clerk-in-training Kayla Coil, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine. Also, present St John's representative Katie Litzau. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the audit & regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll, and claims for payment of \$7,143.18. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Treasurer's report, and stating the Clerk and Treasurer's books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

**Supervisors Report:** Zellmann reported operating a vegetable farm is permitted since it's agriculture.


### Discussion Included:

2. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to accept Wm Mueller & Sons bid for 4500 yds/gravel for 17.78/cubic yd. on township roads in 2022. Goede had gravel tested by ITT and is favorable. Motion carried.
3. Three groups are interested in doing the spring ditch cleanup. St. John's youth group representative Katie Litzau received paperwork/map. Chair Devine will deliver paperwork/maps to the two Zion groups, who have all done this in the past.
4. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve Resolution #2022-5 Reestablishing Precinct and Polling Place. Motion carried.
5. Spring short courses will be held virtually on 3/14, 3/15 & 3/16.
6. Annual fall conference is October 14-15 in St. Cloud.
7. Regular meetings will continue to be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month.
8. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve training of Kayla Menth as replacement for outgoing clerk Lisa Goede because of moving out of township. Motion carried.
