

Camden Township Regular Meeting

October 14, 2021

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, October 14, 2021, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the September regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll, and claims for payment of \$5,849.74. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Treasurer's report, and stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: CD was renewed for 24 months at .30 APY rate with Cortrust Bank. Treasurer Zellmann stated the township should think about transferring some funds from General to Road & Bridge fund next month.

Clerk's Report: Shared Carver County building permits; Mayer Fire station dedication on Sunday, 10/24/21; website has been updated.

Supervisors Report: Supervisor Goede discussed all the time he has donated to the township. Zellmann stated the township appreciates all the money Goede has saved the township and all his knowledge and experience of township and roads. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to pay Goede 5 hours of maintenance work next month. Motion carried.

Discussion Included:

1. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to certify Camden township has 43.43 miles of road. Motion carried.
2. Discussed possible options for winter snowplowing service, including contracting with neighboring townships and/or contractors. Ideal would be 2 plows going at once to get roads cleared faster for residents. Total time to clear all roads is 8-10 hours.
3. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve Assessing Agreement with Carver County. Motion carried.

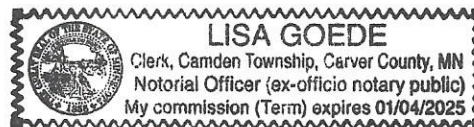
